### Volunteer-Led Programs

- ▶ Teacher manages access and supervises students during the program
- ▶ Timing and duration of program is flexible

### Teacher-Led Programs

- ▶ Teachers can facilitate the program activities and lessons directly with their students or monitor their students while they work independently
- ▶ JA will provide support and access to the program resources
- ▶ Teachers can lead the program at their own pace
- ▶ Programs usually take 2-6 hours to complete

## Key Learning Objectives

### After completing the program, students will be prepared to:

- Discuss the common types of jobs and workplaces
- Describe ways people earn, spend, share and invest money
- Explain the value of tools in helping people get their jobs done
- Identify tools used in different jobs and describe how they are used
